**Biomedical Ethics Topic of Clark University Professor's Talk at QCC**

Worcester – Clark University Professor Patrick Derr, Ph.D., will present a talk on “Justice and International Vaccine Trials: How Ethical Guidelines Fail and How We Can Fix Them,” on **Wednesday, Nov. 9** at 2 p.m. at Quinsigamond Community College, 670 West Boylston Street, Worcester.

Part of the Distinguished Lecture Series at QCC, the talk will take place in the Harrington Learning Center, room 109. The presentation is free and open to the public. An informal reception will follow.

Dr. Derr specializes in philosophy of science and biomedical ethics. Currently, he is working on justice, benefits, and biomedical research on human subjects in less developed nations. Dr. Derr delivered an address on this topic in Nairobi, Kenya to an international audience of scientists and African health officials in March. His lecture will be a slightly revised, very accessible version of this presentation to non-specialists.
