QCC Professors Recognized in “Who’s Who Among America’s Teachers”

WORCESTER – Quinsigamond Community College professors Sharon Gillies, John Lopriore, Roger Meservey and Ken Wong were recognized in the latest edition of *Who’s Who Among America’s Teachers* for their overall teaching excellence.

The nomination process for this recognition program is unique, in that students are asked to honor teachers who have made a difference in their lives and contributed to their future. A community member or peer who recognizes a teacher’s outstanding achievements can also provide a nomination for the award.

The four QCC professors are: Sharon Gillies, a Laboratory Technician and professor in Electronics and Computer Systems; John Lopriore, a professor of Biology; Roger Meservey, also a professor of Biology; and Ken Wong, a History professor and the Coordinator of the Liberal Arts Program and Social Sciences.

Published annually, *Who’s Who Among America’s Teachers* allows students and staff to show their appreciation for a teacher’s efforts and excellence. QCC is proud to have four professors listed in the 2006 edition.
