A lot of students participated and shared their stories. President Pedraja made a speech and shared his story. Mustafa made a 3 minutes speech about his story. Relating to this, Mustafa, as the Vice President will be chairing the Activities Programming Committee and he is trying to make this Committee. Senators interested in joining this committee must contact Mustafa.
4. Ethics Committee	Secretary Jorgo Gushi brought up in the Executive Board meeting the idea of creating the Ethics Committee. The campaign starts on November 7 th .
