The Board of Trustees of Quinsigamond Community College in Worcester, MA invites nominations and applications for the position of President of the College. The Board seeks an accomplished and energetic executive who has demonstrated expertise as an institutional leader to succeed Dr. Gail E. Carberry, who prepares to retire from the presidency after 10 years of distinguished leadership. The new president is expected to be selected by April 1 and to take office by July 1, 2017.

QCC was established in 1963 to provide access to higher education to residents of Central Massachusetts. Since the early 60s, enrollment has grown from 300 to over 11,000 full and part-time day and evening students served.
