

FAFSA Appointment Checklist

For your appointment we request that you bring:

- ✓ a copy of your 2016 Federal Income Tax Returns, if you have filed
- ✓ any 2016 year-end income statements you have received
- ✓ copy of your most recent bank and investment statements as applicable
- ✓ Your (and your parent's if applicable) FSA ID

Please review the following questions.

- ✓ Were you born before January 1, 1995?
- ✓ As of today, are you married?
- ✓ Are you a veteran of or on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces?
- ✓ Do you have children/dependents for whom you provide more than half of their support?
- ✓ At any time, since you turned age 13, were both your parents deceased, were you in foster care or were you a dependent or ward of the court?
- ✓ Are you or were you in a legal guardianship as determined by a court?
- ✓ Are you or were you an emancipated minor as determined by a court?
- ✓ Are you homeless or at risk of being homeless?

If you answered "No" to the questions above, then you also need to include parent information on the FAFSA. Please bring the following documents, as applicable, for your parent(s):

- ✓ a copy of your parents' 2016 Federal Income Tax Return, if they have filed
- ✓ copies of all 2016 year-end income statements your parent(s) have received
- ✓ copy of your parents' most recent bank and investment statements as applicable

Please complete as much as the FAFSA Worksheet as you can before your appointment. You should be able to complete at least Sections 1 and 2 - they are easy and all about you!
