3. SGA strategic Plan Group Discussion		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Memorandum of Understanding: Mustafa proposed a direct partnership with WPI student leadership and athletics. In an effort to come together to combat student issues such as hunger and homelessness. In regards to athletics teams could have team building opportunities such as joint practices. Mustafa proposed that this would be a great opportunity to improve student life at QCC and possibly promote transfers to WPI. In April/May a contract was worked on and he spoke with the previous SGA president at WPI. He plans on communicating with the new president of SGA at WPI. Jorgo said the QCC SGA executive team needs to meet with the SGA executive team at WPI. 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Talent Show: Discussions of a school wide talent show started in December of 2019 with the hopes of holding a talent show on April 24th, 2020. This idea was put on hold due to the Covid pandemic. The hopes were that the talent show would be the most inclusive day next to diversity day. Funds from ticket sales would go toward resources such as the food pantry. Individual school clubs could sell raffles to raise money for their clubs. Lots of ideas were suggested on how to make a possible talent show work virtually. Cheryl Pike mentioned that there can be virtual raffles. The idea of turning it into a fundraiser with an entry fee was mentioned. While members generally like the idea concerns about participation numbers were brought up. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Replacing water fountains: Water bottle filling stations would replace the old water fountains. These new fountains would be water bottle filling stations built into the walls. They would have a motion sensor. Allowing for no touch refills of water bottles for students as opposed to the old style fountains that made it hard to fill a bottle and that students could drink directly from, which in these times of Covid could prove dangerous to one's health. The issue of cost was raised. Possibly \$500-\$800 a station. It was mentioned to maybe switch out one or two fountains per floor. It was also brought up that right now while very few students are on campus could potentially be the best time to replace them as there are less people than usual in the buildings. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Survey Monkey: In an effort to gain student feedback on their transition from in person too remote learning a survey was discussed. This survey would be sent out to all current QCC students. This survey would consist of 5-6 multiple choice questions with the option of answering an open ended question of "other."
