1. Advisor's Report/Open Discussion: Person to speak, Jorgo Gushi and Josh Cole	<p>Jorgo informed us that they will be organizing the election to elect a new SGA president and student trustee. Jorgo let Tara know that he appreciates the work she did as unofficial student trustee.</p> <p>Jorgo also mentioned that they're hoping to send election information and applications tomorrow. He said applications will be due two weeks after they've been sent. They're hoping to hold elections at the beginning of May.</p> <p>Jorgo told us about how he made an amendment to the constitution that in the event of a state of emergency the constitution can be amended. In our current climate of the pandemic we could make a change allowing the SGA president to be taking 6 credits as opposed to the current 9 credit requirement.</p> <p>Members agreed that this would be a good idea going forward.</p> <p>Tara called a motion to make an emergency change to the constitution article 10 section 3 to replace the requirement of SGA president from 9 credits to 6 credits.</p> <p>Tara motioned, Nick second, with all in favor and none against.</p>		

	<p>The motion to amend passed.</p> <p>Tara asked if this was a requirement for other SGA positions as well.</p> <p>Jorgo said no, only the president. There is no credit requirement for the other SGA positions just that they are a current student.</p> <p>Jorgo also let us know that the SAC final meeting and election on April 24, 2021. Jorgo is running for his third year which would make history.</p> <p>Nick joked that Jorgo was like FDR.</p> <p>Josh gave updates that we still haven't heard anything new about the water bottle filling stations. But we got the approval from the business office to go forward with the carwash fundraiser.</p> <p>Armela said she was glad that at least one thing we set out to do is happening.</p> <p>Josh said that the carwash fundraiser closes in 60 days. But it's that time of year where people are going to car washes. He said, hopefully Tara runs for SGA president and gets to use the money we raise. He said, "no pressure."</p> <p>Nick informed all of us that it's not redeemable for self serve car wash only the drive through.</p> <p>Josh said we need to make that known when sharing the info about the car wash. He said we should include those instructions, a map and the QR code that Shauna made to flyers. Then Gina can do what she wants.</p> <p>Tara mentioned that her or Zach could post it to the peer mentoring page. She said she could also share it with the members and attendees of The Blaxck Student Union.</p> <p>Jorgo said he forgot to mention honors and awards. He explained what the Outstanding Leadership Award is. He said the only people who can nominate for this is SGA. He said, "I'm asking you guys for this year from you guys."</p> <p>Tara asked, "We can't nominate individually? It has to be done by SGA?"</p> <p>Jorgo said, "Yes, I can launch a poll and you guys can vote anonymously."</p> <p>Josh said, "Whatever is quickest, they're due tomorrow."</p> <p>Jorgo launched the poll and we all voted.</p> <p>Jorgo said, "We have 6 votes and there is a tie. The tie is between Shauna and Tara.
