<b>1. President's Report:</b> Person to speak, Armela	<p>Armela informed us that she was able to have a meeting with President Pedraja and the Eteam.</p> <p>She said, "I got the idea that theory wanted to help SGA but also buy water stations on their own for the other buildings. I told them we are more also looking for a way to let students know that SGA is here and we are active. I explained also the dilemma whether it was going to go through the foundation or just straight forward. They said we can pay part of it but they don't want to take all of it from us. I did mention that we are doing a fundraiser and our account is going up. Me and Shauna received an email that they want to set up a meeting with us. So there is a high chance we're getting the product and not paying it all and getting the plague."</p>		
<b>2. Advisor's Report:</b> Person to speak, Josh Cole	<p>Josh said to Armela about the water station that that was great news! He said, "For me it's not so much an update but I have a question for Nick. Are we able to track how much money is coming in from the fundraiser?" Nick said, "Yes."</p>

W're also getting another step closer to your fleece's/ It's getting approved by marketing today."</p> <p>Armela said, "Don't forget to order your caps and gowns."</p> <p>I (Shauna) said, "I got mine the other day and my tassels were hanging out of the box. I picked up the box from my porch and they were just hanging there. They didn't pack them well."</p> <p>Josh informed us that he sent us an email about next Thursday's meet with a potential new Director of the Student Life office. He said, "I understand it's during this meeting time, so no pressure." He also let us know that there would be very few people there. They were having maybe 5-10 students.</p>
<p><b>Other Reports:</b></p>	<p>I (Shauna) added to Armelas update by reading my notes from the meeting we had with President Pedraja and the Eteam. I said, "Some of this will sound redundant to Armela but I wanted to read my quick notes from our meeting. They have the funding for the water stations.. They informed us that they don't want to take funding from the students. Steve Marini from facilities suggested we put in half the cost of the station and donate the other half to a clean water initiative. They will still put the plaque with the station. Steve also mentioned that a lot of units are sold out due to the pandemic production has been down. President Pedraja asked Steve to try to procure at least one station and think about the rest later. That way SGA's water station will at least be there."</p> <p>Anita filled everyone in on the last Student Services Council meeting. She said, "We talked about service animal policy. Shauna can you add more information."</p> <p>I (Shauna) said, "Yes, they talked a lot about ESA's. I guess someone brought in a flying squirrel. And there have been incidents where dogs have been loose on campus. ESA's technically not allowed on campus and don't require the type of extensive training a service dog requires so they're revisiting the policy."</p> <p>Anita told us that they also discussed children on campus. and mentioned that the school plans to put in outdoor seating to not have as many individuals in the building at one time. She said, there will be someone at the door asking where you will be going in the building.</p>
<p><b>Open Discussion:</b></p>	<p>Armela said, "Nick, you said we can track how the fundraiser is going?"</p> <p>Nick said, "Yes, you can login and it will show you. I can give you the login information. It's still pretty low right now, we still have to get the word out. Josh and I were talking about the best way to advertise. I was wondering if we should put in that it's \$10?"</p> <p>Josh said, "My thought was \$10 would be the only one they choose."</p> <p>Nick said, "Definitely a good point."</p> <p>Josh said, "\$20 is the most expensive."</p> <p>Nick said, "It's 1 wash for \$10, 2 washes for \$20 and 3 washes for \$30."</p> <p>Josh said, "\$10 per wash is what we will write on the flyer."</p>

	<p>Nick said, "Yeah, we just need to get the word out as best we can."  I (Shauna) said, "I agree."  Josh asked, "Should we mention that SGA gets 50%?" I was glad he loved all of the ideas and asked Steve if he could at least try to procure one water bottle station."  Armela said, "Graduation is coming, are you guys breathing?"  Everybody laughed.
