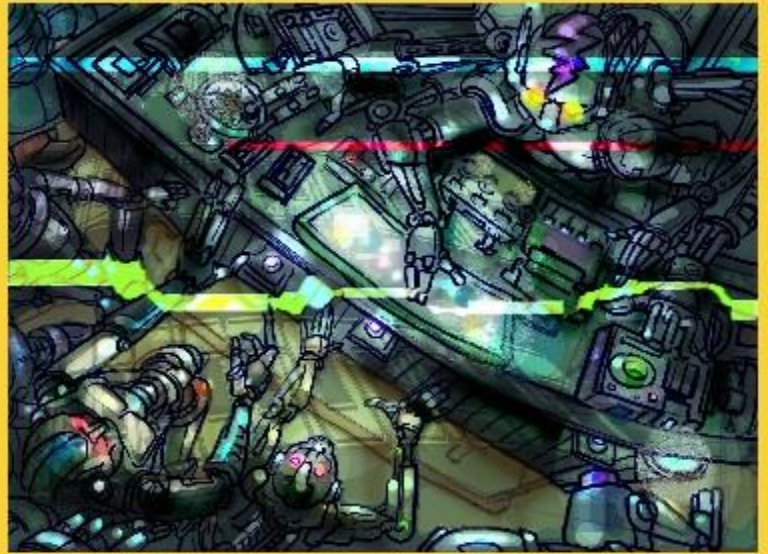


The Sankofa Lecture Series presents
