Dear Mr. McNamara:

Thank you for your recent Public Records Request. The Massachusetts Public Records Law (M.G.L. Chapter 66 & Chapter 4, Section 7(26)) provides that every person has a right to access public information. This right of access includes the right to inspect or be furnished a copy of any public record within ten (10) <u>business</u> days following the receipt of a request. A state agency is only required to provide records that are in existence and is not required to create a new record based on information in its custody to accommodate a specific request.

Your request, received on June 2, for "Any communications between QCC employees and Dave Grossman about the July 15, 2020, "Bulletproof Mind" seminar held at the college; Documents showing any payment to Grossman for this event; Documents showing any payment between QCC and the Northeast Counterdrug Training Center in connection to this event; Any document showing the list of attendees to this event; and Any recordings of the event kept by QCC" has been fulfilled.

There are no records in response to your request, as:

- QCC employees did not communicate with Dave Grossman regarding this seminar.
- The College did not make any payments to Grossman for this event.
- The College did not pay, or receive payment from the Northeast Counterdrug Training Center in connection to this event.
