In accordance with the Massachusetts Public Records Act § 66-10 et seq., I am requesting to obtain copies of the following public records:

Any and all correspondence, memos, and records, from February 1, 2018, through the fulfillment of this request, that mention, reference, or relate to U.S. Senator Elizabeth Warren and/or her commencement speech given on May 18, 2018. This includes, but not limited to, any correspondence with Sen. Warren or her representatives, regarding or related to her delivering the University's commencement address, as well as, but not limited to, any internal communication regarding the same. Please include but do not limit to correspondence relating to the scheduling and any contracts involved including riders or accommodations for the Senator.

In order to help you determine my status to assess fees, you should know that I am requesting on behalf of the Republican National Committee (RNC) and this information is not primarily in the commercial interest of the RNC.


If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$25. However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of Quinsigamond Community College. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The Massachusetts Public Records Act requires a response time of ten business days. If access to the records I am requesting will take longer than this amount of time, please

contact me with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law. Please release all reasonably segregable material.
