Quinsigamond Community College is in receipt of your public records request, dated on or about August 21, 2018, seeking “salary/wage/compensation dataset(s)/database(s) encompassing the three (3) most recently completed reporting periods (either fiscal or calendar year).” Please be advised that the College does not maintain an existing record responsive to your request and according to the Commonwealth’s Public Records Law, MGL Chapter 66, it is not required to create a new public record in order to comply with a request.

Notwithstanding, and in accordance with Section 6A(d) of the law, “[i]f the public record requested is available on a public website pursuant to subsection (b) of section 19 of this chapter, section 14C of chapter 7 or any other appropriately indexed and searchable public website, the records access officer may furnish the public record by providing reasonable assistance in locating the requested record on the public website.”
