RE: Public Records Request

Dear Mr. Grenier:

Thank you for your recent Public Records Request. The Massachusetts Public Records Law (M.G.L. Chapter 66 & Chapter 4, Section 7(26)) provides that every person has a right to access public information. This right of access includes the right to inspect or be furnished a copy of any public record within ten (10) <u>business</u> days following the receipt of a request. A state agency is only required to provide records that are in existence and is not required to create a new record based on information in its custody to accommodate a specific request.

Your request, dated October 5, 2018, "Seeking a Settlement Agreement between the College and/or the Commonwealth of MA and a Plaintiff represented by Nicole Angela Colby Longton (Longton Law Office 300 Main Street 1st Floor, Worcester, Massachusetts 01608). This case may have settled on or about May of 2017. The settlement led to significant changes to the policies regarding sexual assaults on campus." has been fulfilled.

After a diligent search, Quinsigamond Community College has no such records in its care, custody, or control.
