

# **TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

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**Quinsigamond Community College**

**and**

**Anna Maria College**

**Business Administration-Transfer Associate in Science Degree**

**to**

**Sport Management Bachelor Degree**  
*(Fall 2018)*

## General Statement of Purpose

Anna Maria College agrees to collaborate with Quinsigamond Community College (QCC) by providing opportunities for appropriately qualified students in the QCC **Business Administration-Transfer** Associate in Science degree to complete a **Sport Management** Bachelor degree at Anna Maria College. This articulation agreement is designed to facilitate the educational mobility and transfer of students from Quinsigamond Community College to Anna Maria College, encouraging and rewarding the successful completion of their Associate degree program prior to transition to Anna Maria College.

## Requirements and Terms

Anna Maria College and Quinsigamond Community College agree that any student in the **Business Administration-Transfer** program who has earned an Associate of Science degree may transfer their credits toward a **Sport Management** Bachelor degree at Anna Maria College. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- A. Students who have completed the QCC **Business Administration-Transfer** Associate in Science degree with cumulative Grade Point Averages of 2.0 (or higher) will be accepted into the Anna Maria College **Sport Management** Bachelor degree with “core general education completed” status through the sophomore year. Transfer student applicants who do not meet these criteria will be evaluated individually.
- B. Any student meeting the above-stated requirements is eligible to transfer all college-level QCC **Business Administration-Transfer** program coursework (61-62 credits) to Anna Maria College, as defined by the Anna Maria College Registrar’s office. Additional QCC courses may be accepted in transfer; See Section E.
- C. Appendix A lists the approved course equivalencies from the Quinsigamond Community College **Business Administration-Transfer** Associate in Science degree to the **Sport Management** Bachelor degree at Anna Maria College.
- D. All courses applied as transfer equivalencies for Anna Maria College courses ENG 103 Freshman Composition, or ENG 104 Writing Through Literature, must have been completed with minimum grades of C or better in order to be meet the general education requirements of Anna Maria College as stipulated in the college catalog. In cases where equivalent courses have been completed to satisfy requirements of an earned associate’s degree with grades below a C or better, students will receive transfer credits applied to their student transcripts for the completed coursework, however, students will still be required to meet the course standards set forth by Anna Maria College (successful completion of ENG103 and ENG104 with Minimum grades of C or better).
- E. Under this agreement, Quinsigamond Community College students would complete a minimum of 60 credits at Anna Maria College. If students have eligible transfer courses beyond 60 credits or beyond their earned associate’s degree, those credits may be evaluated for acceptance, up to a maximum of 75 transferrable credits.
- F. Students must meet all requirements needed for a Bachelor degree at Anna Maria College including:
  - i. Earning a minimum of 120 credits
  - ii. Maintaining a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
  - iii. Maintaining the minimum required GPA within their program of study as stated in the Academic Catalog

- iv. Satisfying all General Education and Program requirements as stated in the Academic Catalog
  - v. Completing an intent to graduate form and submitting it to the Anna Maria College Registrar's Office one semester prior to the planned date of graduation.
- G. Students covered under this agreement will receive consideration consistent with others seeking financial aid.
- H. Anna Maria College and Quinsigamond Community College agree to communicate any curriculum changes and policies which affect the agreed upon relationship. Both parties reserve the right to amend or revise by mutual consent and in writing this agreement or to change curriculum, whenever feasible.
- I. Anna Maria College will designate an official(s) who will be responsible for all aspects of the articulation program at Anna Maria College. Quinsigamond Community College will designate an individual(s) responsible for all aspects of this agreement at Quinsigamond Community College
- J. Anna Maria College and Quinsigamond Community College will review this agreement every three years and make adjustments or amendments as deemed appropriate to maintain the integrity of each institution as well as for the improvement of the transfer process and student articulation. Pending review and mutual assent, this agreement may be renewed.
- K. The two institutions further agree to communicate to respective publics of the established relationships. This may include informational sessions on the campus of Quinsigamond Community College as well as prominent display of the agreement online via transfer counseling and/or advising services websites.
- L. Either Anna Maria College or Quinsigamond Community College may terminate the agreement by notifying the other party in writing 90 days in advance. Should the agreement be terminated, any Quinsigamond Community College student who has designated and selected this articulation program prior to termination will be allowed to complete the program within a three-year period of time.
- M. This articulation agreement does not preclude Anna Maria College or Quinsigamond Community College from entering into similar agreements with other institutions of higher education.
- N. This agreement is effective on the final date of signature by both institutions.
