PLEASE NOTE:

The Champlain College Professional Studies Division only requires a minimum of 30 credits to be taken at Champlain online. QCC students may take up to 90 credits at QCC and transfer coursework as long as these are applicable credits. Applicability of credits is decided upon after acceptance based upon current Champlain College curricula.

Sixty (60) credits of the CSET-Forensics curriculum are accepted as a block by Champlain. Additional CSET-Forensics credits (9) are also accepted in transfer and may either apply in the remaining 60-credit upper level "completer curriculum" or count as general electives.

For example, since English Composition & Literature II is part of the CSET-Forensics curriculum and also part of Champlain's "completer curriculum," that course would transfer in on top of the 60-credit block. It is likely another 3 credits would transfer in to fill the Social Science elective in the completer curriculum and another 3 credits would come in to complete a 3 credit general elective spot in the completer curriculum.

If a student has completed additional QCC classes that duplicate remaining Champlain classes, those required courses may be waived and students may substitute other courses as open electives.
