

TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Quinsigamond Community College and Fitchburg State University agree to enter into a transfer agreement for the following academic disciplines/programs:

***Healthcare- Practical Nursing (HCPN) and Practical Nursing Certificate (LP and LPE)
to
LPN to Bachelor of Science in Nursing***

Purpose

This agreement is set forth by Quinsigamond Community College and Fitchburg State University in an effort to delineate a transfer student's best options in course selection. This document signifies the ongoing commitment between these institutions of higher learning to promote coordinated curricula of the highest quality. As such, it bears with it the commitment of our respective faculty, and administrative staff to strengthen these ties and address the needs of our students in a mutually beneficial manner.

Terms and Conditions of Transfer

- A. Students graduating from Quinsigamond Community College's Healthcare-Practical Nursing (HCPN) and Practical Nursing (LP and LPE) Certificate programs, with a qualitative grade point average of 83 (B or 3.0) or greater, and upon completion of Fitchburg State University's admissions requirements are guaranteed admission on a space available basis.
- B. In addition, up to 75 credits from the Healthcare-Practical Nursing and Practical Nursing will be accepted and applied to Fitchburg State University's LPN to BS in Nursing program with the following conditions.

The Fitchburg State University LPN to BS in Nursing major requires individual grades of 77-79 (C+ or 2.3) or higher in the following QCC coursework for acceptance:

- BIO 111 Anatomy & Physiology I
- BIO 112 Anatomy & Physiology II
- BIO 241 Nutrition
- BIO 232 Medical Microbiology
- CHM 101 Introduction to the Chemistry of Living Systems

All other coursework from the sending program at Quinsigamond Community College must be completed with grades of C- or higher in order to transfer.

- C. Graduates of QCC's Practical Nursing (LP and LPE) Certificate programs are exempt from completing the National League for Nursing - Nursing Acceleration Challenge Exams (NACE). These applicants are also not required to submit essays or resumes.
- D. The admissions requirements for Fitchburg State University's LPN to BS in Nursing program will be as follows:

1. Grade point average of 83 (B or 3.0) or higher
 2. Current LPN license in good standing
 3. Two letters of recommendation: one from a current employer and one from LPN program faculty on professional letterhead
 4. Completed online application
 5. Official transcripts from all schools attended
- E. Quinsigamond students will be advised to complete the prescribed coursework, and electives as listed in the attached articulation table. Failure to follow these recommendations will result in additional coursework requirements and longer time to degree completion at Fitchburg State.
- F. Acknowledging that students may, and do transfer from a wide variety of majors, this agreement does not prohibit transfer to or from other programs of study at either institution. This agreement suggests optimal transfer routes from Quinsigamond Community College to Fitchburg State University.

This agreement becomes effective July 1, 2023 and will remain in effect through July 1, 2026 with the provision that the terms specified herein will continue to apply to graduates who transfer from Quinsigamond Community College to Fitchburg State University in the day division, within one year of the expiration of this agreement. The faculty at both institutions agrees to meet annually to review the agreement and discuss modifications.
