

Articulation Agreement Between
Quinsigamond Community College
Worcester, Massachusetts
And
Regis College
School of Nursing and Health Professions
Weston, Massachusetts

Quinsigamond Community College (QCC) and Regis College agree to the following:

- I. That the following transfer articulation agreement be adopted beginning on January 1, 2010 and be reviewed annually for changes by either college.
- II. The Colleges agree to notify each other if there are any curriculum changes that necessitate revisions to this articulation agreement.
- III. That Quinsigamond Community College students receive full credit for courses taken under the following:
 - a. Programs
 - i. QCC's Associate in Science Nursing Degree (71 credits) will be accepted toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree at Regis College. (see attached Table A)
 - b. Additional Credits
 - i. Regis College will accept 24 additional credits beyond the Associate in Science Nursing Degree, from Quinsigamond Community College toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree at Regis College. (see attached Table B)
 - ii. Regis College will offer three nursing courses at QCC. These courses include NUR 303 Research Based Practice, NUR 304 Health Assessment and NUR 510 Community Based Nursing at 20% off the Regis College tuition rate. Students must take two Nursing courses per semester to be eligible for financial aid through Regis College.
 - iii. One graduate level course can be taken at a local 4-year college. Regis College must approve the course prior to registration for the course. The course should focus on Leadership/Management/Communication.
- IV. Conditions of Transfer
 - a. Registered Nurses who earn an Associate in Science Nursing Degree at QCC and who meet the admission requirements of 2.0 overall GPA, 2.7 in Nursing, will be accepted at Regis College.
 - b. Students at Quinsigamond Community College will sign an Intent to Enroll form at the beginning of the third year program of study at Quinsigamond Community College or no later than their admission to Regis College. The Intent to Enroll


form will ensure that the entrance standards for the Quinsigamond Community College graduate will parallel standards for Regis College students.

- c. QCC must be accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC) for this agreement to remain valid.
- d. This transfer agreement is effective upon signing by both parties and shall be ongoing unless terminated by mutual assent of the parties or, in the event of unilateral termination without cause, upon one-year prior written notice to the other party. Parties agree to notify each other if there are any changes in the program of study or their curriculum or in any terms in this agreement that have an impact upon this agreement.


V. That Quinsigamond Community College courses will transfer to Regis College as specified by the following table of equivalencies:
