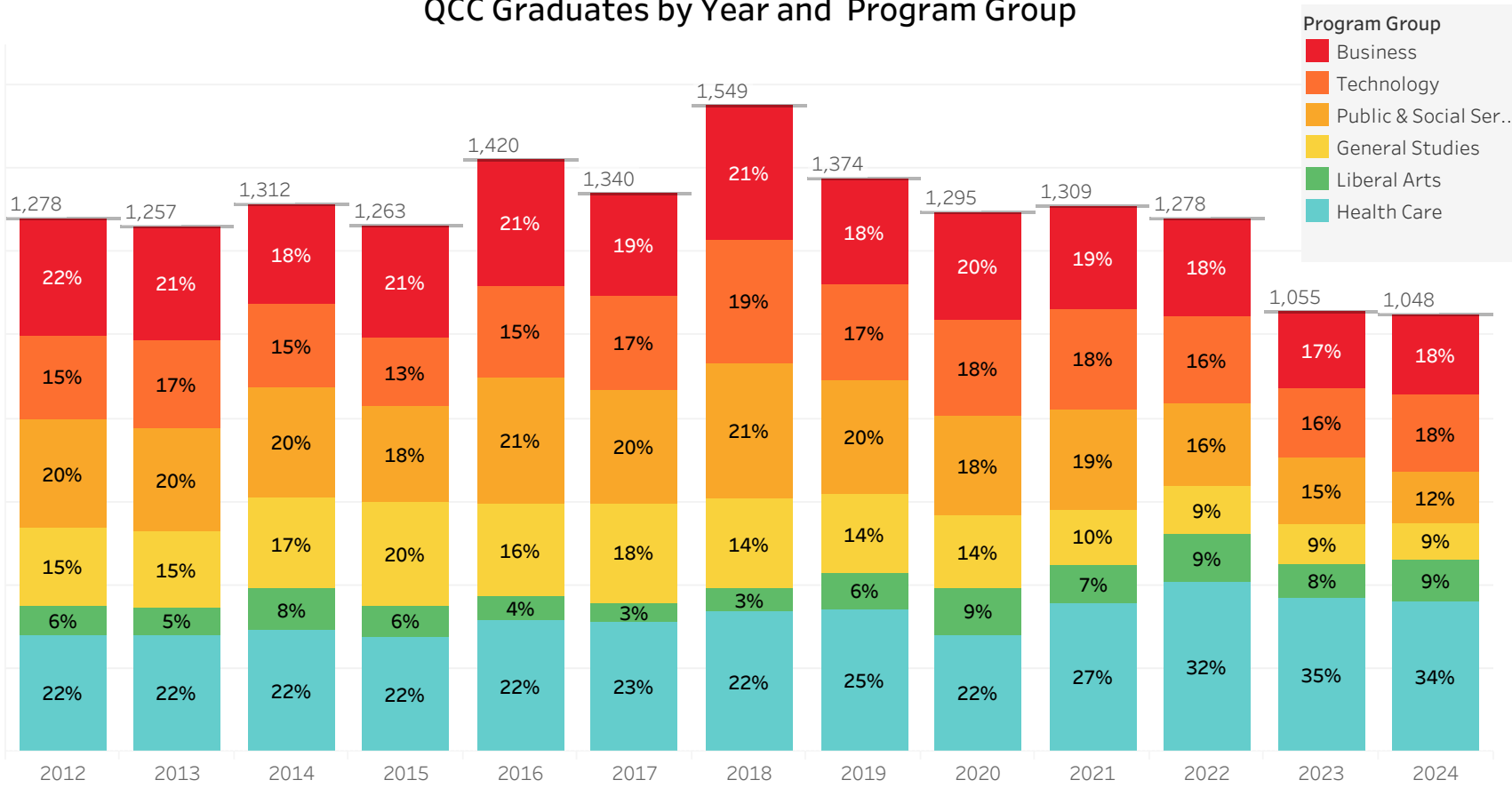


QCC Graduates by Year and Program Group



While the number of Health Care graduates has increased from 2008-2019 (253: 2008 to 343: 2019) the overall proportion of Health Care graduates has declined from 33% (2008) to 25% (2019) due to increases in the overall proportion of graduates in QCC's Technology, Public and Social Services, and General Studies programs. 2021 Graduates were the most impacted by COVID pandemic. (Almost all classes either remote/online starting March/April 2020 -August 2021- impacting: Spring 2020-Summer 2 2021)
