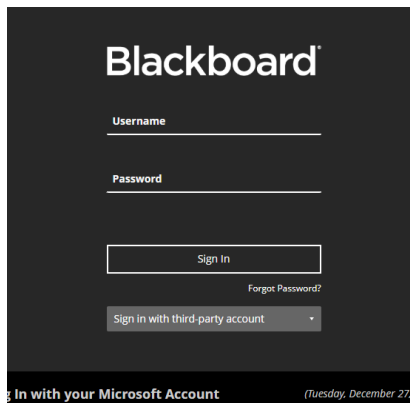


Register for and access QMAT powered by Pearson's MyMathTest

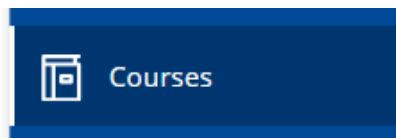
The first time you access QMAT, you will need to register. Follow the steps/pictures below to complete the registration. Once you do this, you will have access to the practice tests and study modules.

Once you have completed the registration, you do not need to do so again. Any time you wish to access the practice tests or study modules, you will go to the QMAT course in Blackboard using fewer steps.

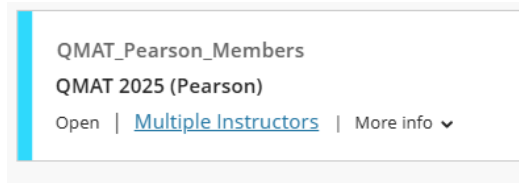
- 1. Open Blackboard.** You can get into Blackboard via the Q by using your Microsoft credentials or by using your ID# and then changing the password – whichever way was sent to you in an email.



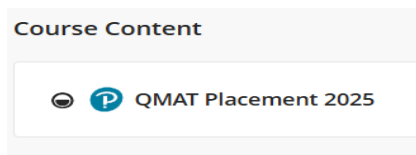
- 2. Click on Courses**



3. Click on QMAT 2025 (Pearson):



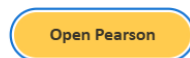
4. Click on QMAT Placement 2025

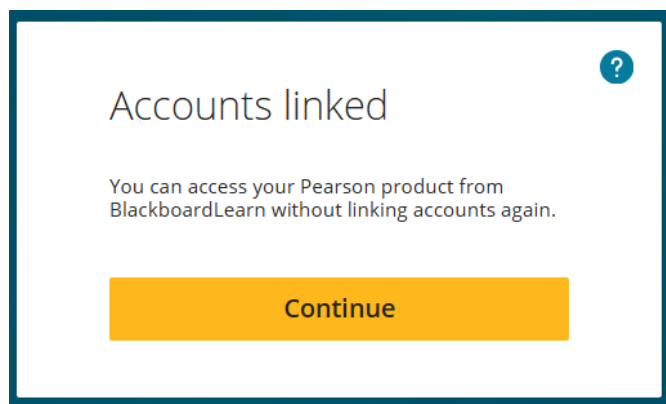
